HR-4791 Free Speech Protection Act of 2023, (Jordan R-OH) (a) would mandate frequent accessible reports from the executive branch agencies detailing the communications between an executive branch agency and Big Tech. (b) ensure that federal grant money is not misused to label media organizations as sources of misinformation. (c) terminate programs that threaten free speech and other constitutionally protected rights. Has 17 R co-sponsors. Companion Bill in US Senate, S-2425, (Paul-KY) has 7 R co-sponsors. Source: House Judiciary Committee

HR-2494 The POLICE Act of 2023, (Garbarino R-NY) would make assaulting a law enforcement official, firefighter or first responder a deportable offense. The deportee, (not legal), would have to either be convicted of the crime or admit to it. Legislation has passed the House 255 R-175 D. Senate companion bill, S-1733 (Budd R-NC) is awaiting action in the Senate Judiciary Committee. *Source: Gov Track Insider*
